DEAUVILLE INTERNATIONAL MEETING COUPE DE FRANCE Rules

The "Coupe de France" is opened to members of a National Senior Golf Association.

Each team is composed of four players plus, eventually, a substitute with handicap not above 24.

The team may be composed of players from different National Associations.

At the entry closing date, teams will be classified according to the total of the team players' handicaps.

Each team receives a running number corresponding to its classification.

Groups of four teams will be set up. Allocation of teams to each group will be done as explained hereafter (example for six groups):

The handicaps of the players will remain those at the entry closing date. Eventual modifications of players in the teams before the first match will not change the running number fixed at the entry closing date. The substitute will take the rank of the player he takes the place.

Incomplete teams may be completed by the A.S.S.G.F. Commission Sportive who will endeavour to select players amidst single players who wish to play in a team but have not set up their team.

Other single players and/or players of teams which have not been completed will play an individual "Coupe de France" as stated below.

GAME ORGANISATION

1 - By teams

- Preliminary phase

In each group, each team will play the three others, in match play with 3/4 of the handicap difference in the order of individual players' handicaps, with:

1st day : team 1/team 4 and team 2/team 3 2nd day : team 1/team 3 and team 2/team 4 3rd day : team 1/team 2 and team 3/team 4

Each player winning his match will receive 2 points for his team. One point will be awarded to each team for a square match.

ASSOCIATION SPORTIVE DES SENIORS GOLFEURS DE FRANCE

Every day, the winning team of each group marks two points in the group; in case of tie each team marks one point.

At the end of the 3rd day, the winning team of each group is the one having obtained the highest number of points in the group over the 3 days.

In the event of a tie, the winning team will be the one having the highest number of individual matches won.

If there is still a tie, the winning team will be decided by the total of "holes up" of individual matches. Thereafter, if still necessary, a "sudden death match play" will have to be played between the first players of each team.

- Final phase

At the end of the 3rd day the four teams, having obtained the highest number of points in each group, will be selected to play the semi finals.

Only one team by group can be selected. In case of a tie, the selection will be done as specified in the preliminary phase.

The semi finals will be played the 4th day of the Meeting as follows:

- 1st team /4th team
- 2nd team/3rd team

Players of each team playing in the order of their handicaps.

The final will take place the last day.

The players of the four final teams will be rewarded.

The players, who will not play the final phase, will have the possibility to play the "Coupe Cael" 4 B Chapman and the "Coupe Blackmer" 4 BMB which will take place the last two days of the Meeting.

2 - Individual players

Players isolated or non integrated in a group will play the "Coupe de France" in stableford net full handicap, on the Deauville Golf Course according to the same rules as the teams.

The selection of the 4 first players, to play the semi finals, will be done by taking the total of the net stableford scores played over the 3 first days.

In event of a tie, the selection will result of the score of the last 9 holes, the 6 last, the 3 last and the last one.

The semi finals and final will be played, in match play with 3/4 of the handicap difference on the Deauville Golf Course.

The semi finalists and finalists will get prizes.
